
RG bird strikes at home - none

Updated to 19 May 2014 (2014 sightings on 29 March and 11 April)

Note: the chart displays the number of days in a given month in which the species was seen. This says nothing of total bird numbers: though commonly with this species one sees an individual or at most 2-3 birds in a day. This is a minimum, as the observer was not present continuously, not observing from dawn to dusk, and not necessarily near the best feeding and roosting sites for the species. Being a game bird, an active dog will somestimes flush them when a human would pass by oblivious.
