May 2010).

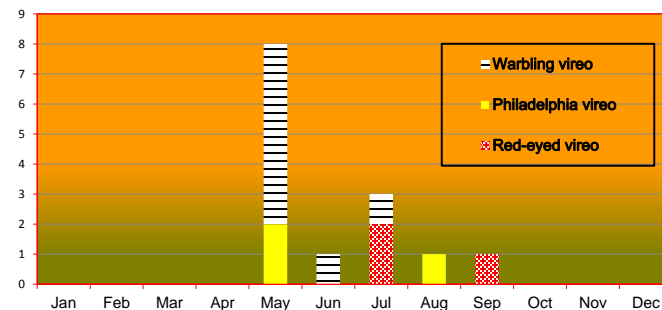
Note: the chart displays the number of

is a bare **minimum**, as the observer was
not present continuously, not
observing from dawn to dusk, and not
necessarily near the best feeding or
nesting sites for vireos.
