

Likely vireo bird strikes at home: one, a warbling vireo most probably struck an attic window, was stunned, and recovered (25 May 2010).

Note: the chart displays the number of days in a given month in which the species were seen. On any given day, either one bird or a pair was seen. This is a bare minimum, as the observer was not present continuously, not observing from dawn to dusk, and not necessarily near the best feeding or nesting sites for vireos.
