

Note: the chart displays the number of days in a given month in which the species was seen. This says nothing direct about total bird numbers: though this sometimes hard-to-spot species is commonly seen as a solitary, diligent explorer of tree trunks. The bird is almost certainly much under-reported in the area, which is why, somewhat tongue-in-cheek, we break our usual rule and display a second sighting just south of the township! A third sighting was actually reported in the township during this period, but the date is not recorded.
